My name is Danielle, I am the registered manager at St Peters Court.

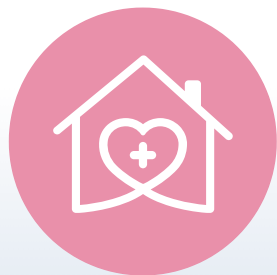

I love to make our residents feel happy and cared for and since starting at St Peters Court I have never looked back

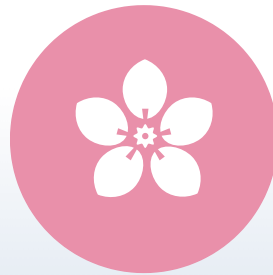

St Peter's Court Care Home is pleasantly situated in scenic surroundings in Wallsend, close to the river Tyne and a short drive away from the picturesque Northumbrian coastline.

We specialise in residential and dementia care within a warm and welcoming environment, with a team of skilled, qualified and, above all, caring professionals.

Dining
